Project Update - May 2014

Early Decanting Works Starts

Please be advised that works are about to commence for the next 11 weeks inside and directly outside **Building 28 - Marine & Tropical Biology 2** to create suitable space for staff moving across from Building 22 and 23. Works are scheduled to commence 7 May and complete 18 July 2014.

As you may be aware Building 22,23 and 44 are being demolished to make way for The Science Place a state of the art 12,000sqm Teaching and Research facility which will commence construction in early 2015.

Some staff and students have already or are about to relocate to alternative locations to make way for modification works in Building 28. The following areas will be affected at varying levels of works:

Building 28: Outside to south - **Temporary Accommodation and storage Units**
Ground Floor Rooms **001,002, 004, 005, 006, 007 and 008**
First Floor Rooms **107,108,110 and 114**
Second Floor Rooms **220, 222 and 224**

Please be aware Construction Workers will be accessing through the Building. Please make sure you take care while passing the works.
